- When the Yomaws (hybrid human-canines) are accused of exhuming and consuming human cadavers, a fearless young detective named Carlos sets out to clear their name, unmask the true culprits and return the lost daughter to the fold.

Paolo Chikiamco is a well-known writer of prose, comics and interactive fiction. He is the editor of Alternative Alamat: Myths and Legends from the Philippines and his work has been published in anthologies such as The Sea Is Ours and The Best of Philippine Speculative Fiction. He's also the co-creator of the comics Mythspace: Ignition and A Sparrow's Roar. He has served as a judge for the Graphic Literature category of the Philippine National Book Awards and is the creator of the #RP612fic Twitter hashtag.

Borg Sinaban is a freelance comic artist and illustrator based in Manila. He's a scifantasy fan and a lover of both soft and hard magic systems. He currently does character design and book covers when not making graphic novels of his own.

Wilson was awarded a Commendation from the Foreign Ministry of Japan, and inducted into the Order of the Rising Sun by the Japanese emperor.

Steven Heine is Professor of Religious Studies and History and Founding Director of the Asian Studies Program at Florida International University. A specialist on East Asian religions and society, especially the origins and development of Zen Buddhism in medieval Japan, Heine has published three dozen monographs and edited volumes. His most recent works include *From Chinese Chan to Japanese Zen, Readings of Dōgen's Treasury of the True Dharma Eye* and *Dōgen: Japan's Original Zen Teacher*.


