Bulgogi Recipe


How to cook bulgogi (불고기)

• Ingredients (4 servings)

450g flank steak
5 tablespoons soy sauce
2½ tablespoons white sugar
¼ cup chopped spring onion
2 tablespoons minced garlic
2 tablespoons sesame seeds
2 tablespoons sesame oil
½ teaspoons ground black pepper
optional : Add onions, carrot and
peppers.

• Directions

- ① Place the beef in a shallow dish. Combine soy sauce, sugar, spring onion, garlic, sesame seeds, sesame oil, and ground black pepper in a small bowl. Pour over beef.
- ② Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour or overnight.
- ③ Preheat an outdoor grill for high heat, and lightly oil the grate.
- ④ Quickly grill beef on a hot grill until slightly charred and cooked through, 1 to 2 minutes per side.





Wilson provides many new renditions of poems that are already considered classics, and also includes the delightful work of poets who are rarely translated, including the female poets Chiyojo and Hisajo, as well as the famous novelist Natsume Sōseki, who, unbeknownst to many, also wrote haiku. An introduction is given for each poet, followed by a selection of that poet's most notable haiku. Audio recordings of the poems are available online in both English and Japanese.

William Scott Wilson holds BAs from Dartmouth College and The Monterey Institute of Foreign Studies, and an MA from the University of Washington. He has worked as a translator and advisor on cultural affairs for the Japanese Consulate-General in Seattle, Washington; a teacher of Japanese language; and a guide for Japanese tourists in South Florida. He has published 20 books that have been translated into 21 foreign languages, including *The Lone Samurai: The Life of Miyamoto Musashi*. His translation of *Hagakure*, an 18th century treatise on samurai philosophy, was featured in the film *Ghost Dog*, by the director Jim Jarmusch. Wilson was awarded a Commendation from the Foreign Ministry of Japan, and inducted into the Order of the Rising Sun by the Japanese emperor.

Steven Heine is Professor of Religious Studies and History and Founding Director of the Asian Studies Program at Florida International University. A specialist on East Asian religions and society, especially the origins and development of Zen Buddhism in medieval Japan, Heine has published three dozen monographs and edited volumes. His most recent works include *From Chinese Chan to Japanese Zen*, *Readings of Dōgen's Treasury of the True Dharma Eye* and *Dōgen: Japan's Original Zen Teacher*.

By the early 1960s, Watts' radio talks aired nationally and the counterculture movement adopted him as a spiritual spokesperson. He went on to write more than 25 books.

Mark Watts is Alan Watts' son and Director and co-founder of the Alan Watts Organization which maintains an archive of all of Alan Watts' writings and talks. Mark has also produced the Joseph Campbell Audio Collection and created archival projects for the San Francisco Zen Center and the Krishnamurti Foundation. He is the host of the *Being in the Way* podcast.





Grilled Beef Meatballs with Sweet Chili Dipping Sauce

One of my favorite street food spots is Luk Chin Anamai on Sornvijai Road, next to the hospital. I actually look forward to doctor visits because I know that I can go grab a bite at the noodle shop afterwards. While their beef noodles are very famous, this shop's meatballs are what I remember best. Unlike most diners who prefer ordering the finely milled, soft beef meatballs, I love the grilled, smoky ones best and think this recipe replicates that texture well.

SERVES 4 PREP TIME: 10 MINUTES COOKING TIME: 10 MINUTES

2 cloves garlic
2 shallots
1/2 inch (1.3 mm) galangal, peeled
3 fresh kaffir lime leaves, stems removed and finely sliced
1 tablespoon shaved palm sugar or white sugar
2 tablespoons potato starch
2 small fish's eye chilies
1 lb (pound) 450 g ground beef, the higher fat the better
1 egg
2 tablespoons fish sauce
1 tablespoon peanut oil
2 tablespoons soy sauce
For garnish: lime wedges, to serve and coriander leaves (optional)
Thai Sweet Chili Sauce (optional)

Thai Sweet Chili Sauce
4 finger-length red chilies (just chilies, lime leaves or both chilies are used in Thailand)
3-5 red bird's eye chilies, or to taste
6-8 cloves garlic, peeled, or to taste
1/2 cup (125 ml) water
1/2 cup (125 ml) shaved palm or white sugar
1/2 cup (125 ml) white vinegar
Salt, to taste
1 tablespoon potato starch (cornstarch or tapioca may be substituted) dissolved in 1 tablespoon warm water



If using wood skewers make sure to soak in water for a couple of hours before grilling.

Make the Thai Sweet Chili Sauce, if using, first so the flavors have time to develop. Put both types of chilies with the garlic in a mortar and pound with a pestle until a paste forms. Set aside.

In a large saucepan over medium-high heat, combine the water, sugar, vinegar, fish sauce and salt.

Add the chili and garlic mixture and simmer until the sugar dissolves. Turn the heat to low and

simmer for 5 minutes to let the flavors develop.

Whisk in the starch mixture and gently simmer for a few more minutes. Remove from the heat, taste and adjust seasoning as needed. Transfer into a jar and let cool.

Puree all the dry meatball ingredients in a food processor until it forms a paste. Then add the meat, egg, fish sauce, soy sauce and peanut oil and blend until fully incorporated and slightly fluffy. The mixture will be soft and sticky. Take a medium-sized pot and fill halfway with water and bring to a simmer. Using very wet hands, scoop a slightly heaped tablespoon of the meatball mixture and roll between palms into a ball approx 1 1/2 inch (3.75 cm) and then drop directly into the water careful not to splatter yourself. Poach the meatballs for 2 minutes and remove from the water with a slotted spoon. Set aside on either a plate or wire rack.

Once the meatballs are not too hot to handle, place them on skewers and grill. Serve with the lime wedges, coriander leaves and Thai Sweet Chili Sauce.
